

- * Group FV2: Same as FV & FV1 except cars thru 1978 & rear suspension is free. Slicks allowed.
- * Group FV3: 1979 & newer cars that comply to current SCCA GCR. Tires as required by current SCCA GCR.
- * Tires would be per current CSRG rules or current SCCA GSR, as appropriate for each sub-class.

These forms are not meant to replace the sheets you will receive by e-mail with your information packet but are provided as information and as a work sheet so you may inspect and gather all the data necessary to complete the official form.
