Tech will be open in the staging area and will move to the paddock in the late afternoon until there is not enough light. Registration will open at 5:00 PM, when we get access to the building.

Please also note that if you plan to enter at the track on Saturday, chances are good that you will miss some morning track time, because you will have to enter, go through Tech, and then complete registration all of which takes time. So get there Friday before dusk, or register on line before 10 pm of April 25.


Assistant Race Director Needed

Entrant Packets

All race entrant packets for CSRG events, including Tech Forms and gate tickets, will be held at Will Call outside the track security/ticket gate or at Registration. We are no longer mailing them to entrants. The packets are held in the name of the Entrant. We advise you to print a copy of the Pre-Tech Worksheet

Download Medical Forms

Click on CSRGmedform13.pdf to download a copy of the form. You do not need to send in the original Medical Form with the "wet" signature to CSRG. You can now keep your original and either mail a clear photocopy or, better yet, scan the complete four page form and email it to: Race Director@csrgweb.org.

It would be wise to file the original until its medical certification period expires. The scan and email system is the preferred method, otherwise mail the forms

to CSRG at P.O. Box 3223, San Rafael Ca. 94912.
