## Race Groups 1,2 & 3

The CSRG Board has been asked to consider a proposal to divide each of Race Groups 1, 2 & 3 into sub-groups 1A, 2A, 3A & 1B, 2B & 3B. Cars built to the 1967 rules set will run in the 'A' sub-group & cars built to 1972 rules will run in the 'B' sub-group. Each sub-group would be scored independently & the results would reflect the split. The primary purpose of the split group is to allow cars that look similar to be in the same race group instead of spread between Group 8 & Groups 1,2 or 3.

Click on <u>CSRGmedform13.pdf</u> to download a copy of the form. You do not need to send in the original Medical Form with the "wet" signature to CSRG. You can now keep your original and either mail a clear photocopy or, better yet, scan the complete four page form and email it to: Race Director@csrgweb.org.

It would be wise to file the original until its medical certification period expires. The scan and email system is the preferred method, otherwise mail the forms to CSRG at P.O. Box 3223, San Rafael Ca. 94912.
