- * Group FV3: 1979 & newer cars that comply to current SCCA GCR. Tires as required by current SCCA GCR.
- * Tires would be per current CSRG rules or current SCCA GSR, as appropriate for each sub-class.

Tires - DOT approved, Good Year Blue Streak, other tires will be considered on an individual basis





You can get a head start on your Tech Inspection tasks by downloading the Pre-Tech Inspection Forms. These forms are not meant to replace the sheets you will receive by e-mail with your information packet but are provided as information and as a work sheet so you may inspect and gather all the data necessary to complete the official form. Click <u>TechWorksheet</u> to print your copy of the worksheet.

You can now keep your original and either mail a clear photocopy or, better yet, scan the complete two page form and email it to: <u>Race.Director@csrqweb.org</u>.
